## Personal Equipment Checklist

### Items You Must Bring

- Passport Book or Card
- Clothes for 6 days (including some “church clothes” for Sunday)
- Bible
- VBS Program Manual
- Pen or pencil and paper
- Training and Event Journal
- Warm sleeping bag
- Warm sweatshirt or jacket (believe it)
- Hand sanitizer
- Flashlight
- Wet wipes (lots)
- Folding chair (for chapel)
- Toiletries (towel, washcloth, soap, shampoo, hair brush, etc.)
- Insect repellent
- Hat
- Sunscreen (at least SPF 15)
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Personal water bottle
- Team T-shirt
- Personal medication

### Items You May Want To Bring

- Air mattress or foam pad (camping size: 27 inches wide) or camping cot
- Pillow
- Work Gloves
- Shower shoes (flip flops)
- Makeup (please girls only ☺)
- Pajamas
- Air spray (for toilettes)
- Camera & film
- Talcum powder
- Spending money
- Extra Shoes
- Musical instruments

### Items You Must Not Bring

- Lighter, matches, stove etc. (very dangerous in “tent city”)
- Weapons (firearms, Rambo knives, etc. – illegal in Mexico)
- Electronic games
- Personal sound equipment (iPod, CD player, etc.)
